Statement of Objectives For

Kiwanis Vocational Homes

For Youth

1. Program Objectives for Kiwanis Vocational Homes For Youth:

The program objective for Kiwanis Vocational Homes For Youth is to eliminate behaviors which will not allow youths to remain a part of their home or respective communities and to assist parents in learning appropriate techniques in guiding their children.

The objectives are reached through regular counselling offered by a staff psychologist and counselors coupled with vocational training in such fields as forest management, heavy equipment operation, carpentry, auto mechanics, and welding.

Youths will be encouraged to use their energies in a constructive manner and through learning skills, by gaining pride in their ability to learn and perform, inappropriate behavior will be lessened or eliminated.

Regular counselling sessions with parents will be scheduled when ever possible at the Center where the youths can be in attendance.

When the youths and parents have reached the objectives, the youth will return home with follow-up supervision.

When parents are unable or unwilling to respond to counselling, the youth will be referred for foster care placement.

2. Intake Procedure:

Intake procedure consists of a written referral to this agency requesting a placement with included appropriate
